INTERNATIONAL FORUM FOR INVESTOR EDUCATION ELECTS NEW BOARD OFFICERS

RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL – 7 June 2017 – The International Forum for Investor Education (IFIE) elected new officer positions during its Annual IFIE Members meeting, following recommendations from the IFIE Global Advisory Board.
